

INCIDENT 048351; I-40 WB MM131

April 6, 2010

Conover Fire Department was dispatched to a reported MVC with roll-over and patient inside vehicle on Interstate 40 West Bound at mile-marker 131. Conover Fire Department response included two Engine Companies and Chief to the MVC. Upon arrival, FD personnel found a single vehicle MVC with roll-over and occupant out of vehicle speaking to NC Highway Patrol. Vehicle did roll-over twice and struck the guardrail before hitting the concrete bridge railing, however the occupant escaped the without injuries. It was reported on initial dispatch that the vehicle was struck by another vehicle however that was not determined to be the case, no other vehicles were involved. The lone occupant of the vehicle refused treatment by EMS. Fire Department personnel remained on scene to assist with traffic control while NC highway Patrol investigated the crash and vehicle removed from roadway. Assignment complete, all personnel returned to quarters.
