

## INCIDENT 049997; 300 Block Herman Sipe Road NW; Motor Vehicle Collision

March 30, 2011; 1034 hours

Conover Fire Department was dispatched to a reported MVC in the 300 block of Herman Sipe Road NW. Upon arrival of Conover Fire Engine 1, personnel found a two vehicle collision in the roadway, involving two passenger vehicles, with moderate frontal impact and one vehicle sitting on top of the other. After investigation, Fire Department personnel found only one occupant in the vehicles reporting an injury. The occupants of one vehicle was treated was released on scene, and the driver of the second vehicle was transported to the medical facility by Catawba County EMS with minor non-life threatening injuries. Fire Department personnel assisted by Newton-Conover Rescue Squad and Catawba County EMS packed the patient for transport to the medical facility. Fire Department personnel and apparatus remained on scene for vehicle removal and traffic control while Conover PD investigated crash. Traffic along Herman Sipe Road NW was shut down for a short while until the vehicles could be removed. Conover Fire was assignment complete, all personnel and apparatus returned to quarters.
