Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

Catawba County will hold their “Residential Household Hazardous Waste Collection” event on Saturday, November 5, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at LP Frans Stadium, Home of the Hickory Crawdads, (2500 Clement Boulevard NW) in Hickory. All types of general household hazardous waste, including electronics and paint, will be accepted. A plastic bag recycling drop will be provided by Keep Catawba County Beautiful. This event is for the citizens of Catawba County and is free of charge. No business waste will be accepted.
