Conover Code Enforcement – Spring Cleaning



As spring cleaning begins for 2015, we will all get outside to enjoy the pleasant weather in our yards. Use that fresh spring energy to make the outside of our home as beautiful as the inside by making sure that nuisance items are not in your own yard.

Here is a list of items commonly stored in yards that Code Enforcement targets for removal:

- Any item that collects water that mosquitoes may breed in.
- Any interior furniture not meant to be stored outside including couches, mattresses and box springs.
- Outside furniture that is in disrepair.
- Wood products and paper that may include used or new lumber, cardboard boxes and other paper type items.
- Any automotive parts including car batteries, tires, engine parts, auto body parts and automotive tools.
- Appliances like stoves, washers, dryers and other appliances used in and for the home.
- Storage containers that are either empty or used for storing other items.
- Clothing, rags, blankets and sheeting.
- Garbage, brush or trash in general.

Efforts to remove these items will improve the aesthetics and values of the neighborhoods in Conover. If you see these items in your neighborhood, call Code Enforcement at 828-464-4698 and we will make sure we get the items removed for the well-being of Conover.
