Help With Spring Cleaning in Conover

Nuisance storage violations are an eyesore on any community. They bring down property values and put a damper on the pride you have for your own property. The difference that exists in Conover is that we have been actively eliminating nuisance storage in the community for years. Although this program rids Conover of nuisance storage the job is never finished. With the help of the community we can identify places where nuisance storage exists and make steps to reduce those violations.

The main things to look for and report are:

- Appliances – washers, dryers, refrigerators and other types of appliances
- Automotive Parts – tires, engine parts, batteries and other parts
- Building Material – used or new wood stored for long periods, buckets, demolition debris
- Household Debris – garbage, rags, clothing, storage containers, interior furniture and household waste
