2017 CONOVER FARMERS MARKET CALL FOR VENDORS

The Conover Farmers Market is now accepting vendor applications for their 2017 season and they would love for you to join their market family! The 2017 season runs from April 22 to October 7, with markets every Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 12 Noon in downtown Conover. They are accepting all kinds of vendors, but are in high demand for the following:

Fresh Bread
Wine
Cheese
Mushrooms
Fruits (Blueberries, Raspberries, Figs, Apples, and more)
Take-and-Bake Prepared Foods
Fresh Herbs



All vendors must grow or craft 100% of their product within 75 miles, and they don't allow any resale. All farmers will have a mandatory inspection by the market manager, and all bakers must have a certified inspected kitchen by NCDA.

During winter months water system failures can occur due to freezing temperatures.


