# **Conover Code Enforcement - Nuisance Storage Violations**

Finding and removing nuisance storage violations within the City of Conover is a continuing battle. Through persistence and education of the code, Conover's goal of reducing nuisance storage violations will help keep Conover a healthy and happy community. With the help of the community, nuisance storage violation can be brought to light to the Code Enforcement Officer by reporting suspected violations and allowing the abatement process to begin. Reporting and removing nuisance storage positively affects property values, city appearances and the morale of both citizens and visitors.

Below are typical items that are considered nuisance storage. - Doors
- Bumpers
- Batteries

## **General Nuisance Storage**

- Buckets/Plastic Containers
- Unused Construction Lumber
- Interior Furniture
- Damaged Exterior Furniture
- Mattresses or Box Springs
- Loose Household Trash
- Indoor Appliances
- Piles of Metal



## **Overgrowth, Pests and Unsanitary Conditions**

- Grass or weeds over a 12" Average
- Stagnant Water
- Any Collection of Garbage
- Food or Animal Waste
- Leaking or Backed Up Sewer Lines
