

THE VIETNAM TRAVELING MEMORIAL WALL ®

The City of Conover is hosting the Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall on September 8-11, 2017 at Conover Station. The Traveling Wall stands six feet tall at the center and almost 300 feet from end to end. All 58,272 names of those who fell are listed, just as it is in Washington, D.C. Arrival and setup is September 7th. The City will need help from adults (18 & older). We also need veterans willing to share their stories of service with school children and to teach history lessons about the Vietnam War. Other items needed are; landscaping, shelter & tents, hotel rooms, PTSD counselors and chaplains. If you would like to volunteer time or resources please contact Lt. Downtown Streetscape Project

Construction is underway on the 1st Avenue area streetscape project. The goal of the project is to create a more inviting, attractive and walkable downtown. New “curb extensions” will provide areas for trees and landscaping. The majority of parking spaces will remain, as only 6 on-street, parallel parking spaces will be lost. New landscaped medians will take place of two existing painted medians, and a new median near Bowman Drug will create a safer crosswalk for people to get from one side to the other. Work will continue through the summer, so please use caution and keep an eye out for workers and equipment.
