City of Conover Utility Services

In March, the City of Conover suspended disconnection of utility services for non-payment of bills and assessment of late fees due to the COVID-19 pandemic, to ensure individuals had access to potable water. The City of Conover has adopted a utility payment plan to assist customers with satisfying any past due balances while continuing to receive service. Beginning August 1, 2020, the City will resume normal business practices and procedures for utility service; including assessment of late fees and disconnection of service for non-payment.
