

Golf Cart Accessibility Conover, North Carolina

Conover City Code Article VII allows for a licensed driver to operate golf cart type vehicles on streets in the City limits with certain restrictions, including the exception of some streets as illustrated on this map.

Streets shown as not accessible are not to be used but may be crossed at intersections. Streets shown as not crossable shall not be driven or crossed.

A golf cart may be operated on all public streets in the City of Conover with a posted speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour or less, with the exception of the entire length of 4th St SW, 10th St NW, 7th St Pl SW, Emmanuel Church Rd, 1st St E, 1st St W, 1st Ave N and 1st Ave S, and Herman-Sipe Road.

A golf cart may cross, at a perpendicular angle (ninety (90) degrees), all public street intersections in the City of Conover with a posted speed limit of forty-five (45) miles per hour or less with the exception of:

- i. All intersections on Conover Blvd From Conover Blvd W at Fairway Dr SW to Conover Blvd E at 4th St SE.
- ii. All intersections from the intersection of 1st Ave S/N, 1st St E/W, 2nd Ave NE (known as the Five Points intersection) to 5th Ave NE/SE.
